The primary role is to perform regular maintenance, preventative maintenance and operational procedures on the Municipality's water treatment and distribution, wastewater collection and fire hydrant systems.

Work performed:

Under the direction of the Utilities Manager & Water/Wastewater Lead Hand:

- Analyses water samples to determine acceptability and efficiency of treatment processes relating to public health and environmental protection service standards.
- Assists in development of and performing tasks relative to the preventive maintenance program for the municipal utility operations.
- Repairs and installs components of the water/wastewater distribution systems.
- Performs tasks necessary to the daily operations of the utility systems.
- Collects of and compiles data pertaining to the utility systems.
- Responds to emergency situations involving the Municipal utility systems.
- Provides advice and information to the water/wastewater supervisor on repairs, capital works and improvements to the utility systems.
- Inspects and files reports on the utility installations.
