

Rail Shop Services is looking for either a a part-time Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) Operator or a full-time position split between WWTP Operator and Shop Labourer.

Waste Water Treatment Plant Operations:

- 20 hours per week operating an industrial pre-treatment Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) (4 hours per day, Monday – Friday)
- WWTP hours vary depending on scheduled vacuum truck deliveries and maintenance/cleaning activities, but are generally 7:00AM to 3:30PM Mondays and Thursdays, and 7:00AM to 11:00AM Fridays.
- Work consists of starting and stopping WWTP batch operations, daily logs of treatment process and equipment status, receiving and unloading of vacuum trucks, scheduling for collection and offsite disposal of collected sludges and recovered oil, chemical inventory management and replenishment as necessary, WWTP housekeeping to maintain clean, professional, and ergonomic work environment, quarterly draining and cleaning of process tanks and vessels, and routine preventative and minor mechanical maintenance activities as required.

Shop Labourer:

- If full-time, the balance of the work week will be general shop labour as required, including operating tools and heavy machinery, as well as shipping and receiving.
- Potential for plumber/electrician apprenticeship opportunities.
- Desired skills: Experience with hand tools, forklift/skid steer operation, metal fabrication, metal working, power tools, shipping and receiving.

Qualifications: Graduate of Water and Wastewater Technician program or similar. Alternative relevant experience will also be considered.

Upon completion of a probationary period, a full benefits package will be offered if full-time.
