Working under the guidance of the supervisor, you will be responsible for conducting the daily operation and maintenance of our facilities.

The main responsibilities of the position include, but are not limited to:

- Carry out daily operations of the facility (monitoring, reporting, chemical transfers)
- Complete and compile data of daily inspections, monitoring, and sampling as required
- Report operational problems to supervisor
- Help supervisor with maintenance and repair of equipment, and cleaning of facilities
- On call duties as per the schedule
