- ITA Certificate of Qualification of an Industrial Electrician.
- Certificate in Leadership training course from a recognized post-secondary institute.
- Possess and maintain a valid Class 5 driver's licence and produce and maintain a clean driver's abstract.
- 3 years of supervisory/leadership experience within the past 7 years.
- 3 years' experience as a Journeyman Industrial Electrician who inspects, installs, tests, troubleshoots, repairs, and services industrial electrical equipment and associated electrical and electronic controls within the past 6 years.
- 3 years' experience working with SCADA Systems within the past 6 years.
- 3 years' experience in project management, including assisting with the planning and implementation of project plans; overseeing the construction of minor capital projects; and leading staff and contractors involved in the projects, within the last 7 years.

The rate of pay for this permanent, full-time, CUPE bargaining unit position is **\$41.40 per hour** based on a 40-hour work week and includes a comprehensive benefits package.
