Duties

- Operate and maintain Rogers Pass well water treatment plant and wastewater treatment plant
- Operate seasonal campground and waysides small water systems
- Maintenance of intakes, water valves, compressors, UV system, sand filter
- Collection and recording of water/wastewater samples, chlorine residuals, flow readings, clarity, etc
- Use of software (SCADA), spreadsheets, and word processing
- Plan and supervise water and wastewater operations
- Supervision of staff (one employee, and students as necessary)
- Diagnose and resolve technical and maintenance issues
- Develop industry networks and engage relevant parties to achieve goals
