The City of Abbotsford is pleased to share that it has a unique opportunity for an experienced water treatment and supply professional to join its team as the **Manager of Water Supply**. Reporting to the Director of Utility Operations, the Manager provides leadership, direction, and management to a group of professionals responsible for managing and operating the Joint Abbotsford/Mission water supply system.

The water supply team comprises approximately ten employees and sits within the Utility, Operations division of the Operations Department. The team is responsible for the quantity and quality of water processed and conveyed through the City's water treatment facilities, transmission mains, storage reservoirs, and pumping and pressure-reducing valve stations.

With the support of two Supervisors and an Engineering Technologist, the Manager is responsible for providing leadership and guidance to a team of skilled Water Operators responsible for producing potable water for customers in Mission, Abbotsford, and the Fraser Valley Regional District. The team oversees process and treatment equipment and ensures regular and emergency repairs are carried out; they are also responsible for water supply and water quality monitoring through online systems.

The ideal candidate will be a collaborative and proven leader with a reputation for being an experienced manager who can lead, motivate, and engage a diverse team of professionals and coach and mentor for future succession. They will have strong communication and interpersonal skills, allowing them to build credible and trusted relationships with their team, contractors, regulators, and throughout the City, along with providing expert advice, support, and guidance.
