- Assist CCTV operator with all tasks related to CCTV pipe inspections and manhole inspections
- Perform routine maintenance on CCTV and associated equipment
- Assist with condition assessment rating on underground infrastructure and enter data into CCTV software program (GraniteNet)
- Assist in other water/sewer/storm repairs and maintenance as required
- Ensure compliance with safety standards
- Participate in the 24-hour on call schedule on a rotational basis

- 1 or more years' experience operating and maintaining CCTV equipment will be considered an asset
- Experience reading construction plans and drawings of installed buried infrastructure
