Job duties:

- Safe, efficient, and compliant operation of a Level III WTP and Level II MBBR WWTP currently under construction, as required and based on Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's)
 - Observation, preventative maintenance, and station checks of the water treatment plant and the wastewater treatment plant
 - Observation, preventative maintenance, and discharge of wastewater treatment system
 - Shift work when required, working alone and participation in the on-call schedule
 - Performing facility operation and maintenance tasks related to process monitoring and optimization
 - Laboratory and field analysis
 - Reporting and detailed record keeping
 - Responsible for meeting all Federal and Provincial Legislative Regulations.
 - Responsible for maintaining required reporting data for multiple stakeholders and agencies
 - Ensure quality control and standard method practices are being utilized to ensure the production of safe drinking water and environmentally acceptable wastewater effluent
 - Participates in contracted services for utility projects
