Our ideal candidate:

- Must have the ability to successfully complete the Alberta Level III Water Treatment Certificate.
- Sound knowledge of current practices, materials, tools/equipment and methods used in Water Treatment Plant operations, laboratory and maintenance.
- Ensures accurate completion of operational, maintenance and other records necessary to ensure Alberta Environmental and Protected Areas Approval and plant process requirements are being met.
- Ensures by written and verbal communication that administrative and maintenance personnel are kept informed regarding the plants' operational and mechanical status.
- Performs sampling and laboratory tests, as required.
- Is required to properly batch, mix and handle chemicals as required.
- Sound knowledge of plant heating, ventilation, electrical and instrumentation / control, process, mechanical and SCADA systems.
- Knowledge of computer programs such as Microsoft Office and Hach WIMS would be an asset.

Qualifications:

- Possess Grade 12 with advanced Math 30 and Chemistry 30.
- Must possess or have the ability to obtain a Level 3 Alberta Environment Water Treatment Certificate.
- Must hold a valid Standard First Aid Certificate and WHMIS certification.
- An equivalent combination of management approved training and experience may be considered.
- Required to obtain an Alberta Level 3 Water Treatment Certification within the time frame outlined below. This includes the completion of an assigned study program. Progress as defined by the WTP Superintendent or Manager of Water & Wastewater Treatment must be achieved within the defined period set in offer of employment period.
- Valid Class 5 driver's license with an acceptable driving record;
- Equivalent combination of management approved experience will be considered.
