Pool Operations and Maintenance

- Conduct daily inspections of pool facilities, including testing water quality (pH, chlorine, alkalinity).
- Adjust chemical dosing to maintain proper water safety standards.
- Perform routine pool maintenance, including vacuuming, cleaning skimmer baskets, and checking equipment.
- Monitor and manage chemical tanks, ensuring appropriate levels of sodium hypochlorite and hydrochloric acid.
- Ensure pools are properly maintained, secure when not in use, and compliant with safety regulations.
- Collect and submit weekly bacteriological samples to Alberta Health.
- Assist with seasonal pool openings and closings.

Water & Wastewater System Support

- Assist in monitoring and operating water treatment systems, ensuring proper chemical dosing and compliance with regulations.
- Collect and test water samples for chemical and bacterial content, maintaining accurate logbooks.
- Monitor computerized control systems and assist with troubleshooting water treatment equipment.
- Support the operation and maintenance of wastewater treatment systems, including aerators, UV disinfection, and lift stations.
- Conduct routine inspections and minor repairs on wastewater collection systems.
- Ensure compliance with environmental and health standards in water and wastewater operations.
