**Job Position Summary:**

Posting is for a full-time permanent position, 40 hours per week on average, with overtime/oncall weekend shifts. The ideal candidate would hold: Water Treatment Level II, Water Distribution I, Wastewater Collection I, and Wastewater Treatment I Certification. Willing to work and train towards these certifications with the right candidate.

**Responsibilities include:**

- Carrying out preventative maintenance, cleaning, repairs, inspection of water and

wastewater systems and equipment.

- Testing and analyzing water quality for chlorine residual, turbidity and other parameters
- Interpreting data from instrumentation and alarms; analyzing, calibrating, and troubleshooting problems, developing and implementing solutions
- Monitoring and adjusting disinfection systems, including use of the SCADA and chlorine handling.
- Perform seasonal distribution preventative and reactive maintenance (i.e., hydrant flushing, winterization, line flushing, sewer flushing, valve exercising, contractor supervision for repairs)
- Lift station monitoring
- Water line locating
- Monthly scheduled water meter reads, commercial, and residential
- Be motivated, flexible and a team player
- Respond and communicate efficiently to client inquiries and maintain good relations with the public, co-workers, and contractors
- Participating in record keeping of the water systems performance, including operational records, readings, maps, and shift logs.
- Safety-consciousness- demonstrating commitment to safe work practices, ensuring all tasks are carried out in compliance with the current rules, regulations and standards governing water supply, water/wastewater treatment, water distribution and wastewater collection.
- Participate in company safety program
- Responding to emergency call outs/ stand by as required.
