Accountable to the Operations Manager, this position requires an individual with effective organizational, analytical, communication and interpersonal skills, the ability and desire to work independently, exercise initiative and foster good working relationships.

The main responsibilities of the position include but are not limited to:

- -Working with management and leadership to ensure water treatment and distribution operations run smoothly and that maintenance and repair work is completed
- -Completion of lab and quality assurance tests
- -Maintain time, material and equipment use records
- -Responsible for maintaining adequate inventory of all chemicals, parts, plant and lab supplies

- -Complete outside rounds
