- City of Calgary The City of Calgary is advancing an innovative solution to address increasing heating demands at the Fish Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant with the installation of Alberta's first, and Canada's second, Wastewater Heat Recovery (WWHR) facility.
- Town of Cardston The Town of Cardston is upgrading the aging wastewater treatment system to an advanced Membrane Aerobic Biofilm Reactor (MABR) technology. The project will be the first standalone, full-scale deployment of MABR technology in Western Canada.
