- Interpret test results and adjust treatment process as necessary;
- Troubleshoot and correct process issues and mechanical failures;
- Complete and submit all associated paperwork, as required, for regulatory and safety record keeping requirements.

- Current Level I or II Water Treatment Operator Certification (proof of certification is required);
- Ability to lift 25 kg (55lb);
- Intermediate to advanced mechanical knowledge;
- Ability to work under pressure quickly and efficiently;
